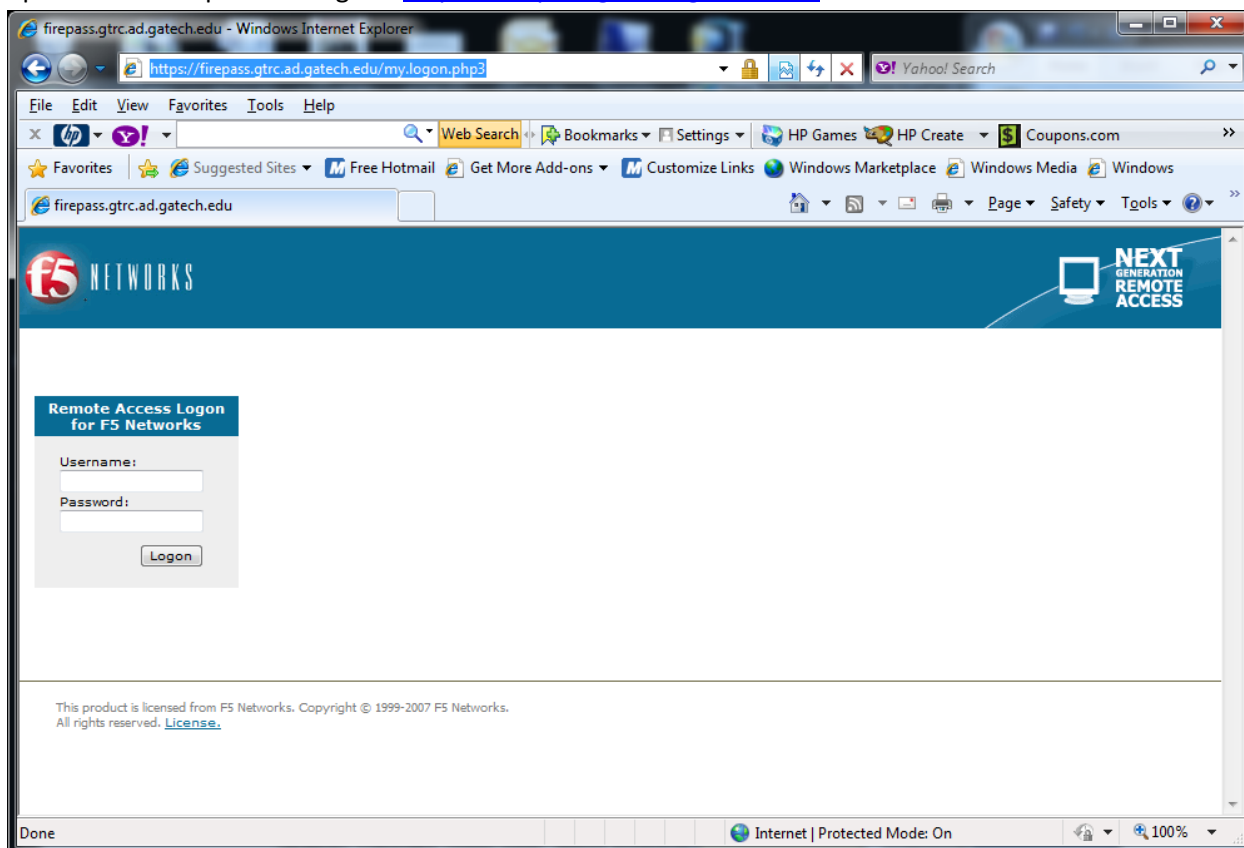


Using Firepass

Installing and using Firepass

Installing Firepass is also done through an Internet Explorer webpage. You will need administrative rights to the computer to install fire pass. You do not need administrative rights to use Firepass once it is installed

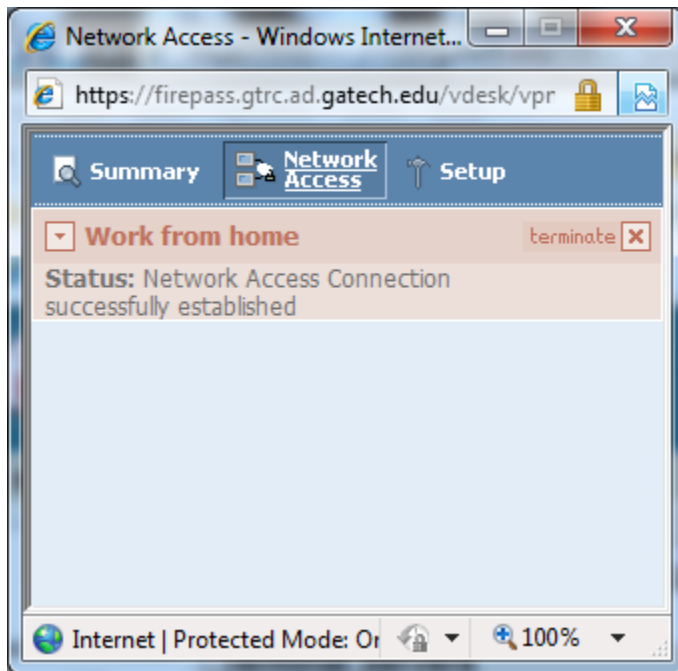
1. Open Internet Explorer and go to <https://firepass.gtrc.ad.gatech.edu> .



2. Log into Firepass with the ID and password you were given by Cornell or Keith.
3. If you have never logged into Firepass before you will be prompted to change your password and then login with your new password.
4. You will click the work from home option to use Firepass.
5. The first time you use fire pass on a machine you will be prompted to install the Active X controls. The prompt will be on a yellow banner at the top of the small Internet Explorer window. When you click on the yellow banner one option is to install the ActiveX controls. You may be prompted up to three times to install, this is because there are multiple controls the install.

6. If the Active X controls are installed successfully you should see the following screen:



7. The next time you use Firepass it should go directly to this screen without prompting for Active X controls.
8. While using fire pass you will minimize the Internet Explorer windows not close them.
9. When you are finished using fire pass click on the terminate link from the small window, then logout from the larger window.
10. You are now disconnected from the GTRC/OSP network.
