Reference is made to the Contractor Purchasing System Review (CPSR) report issued on 27 January 2006 for the review that was conducted at Georgia Institute of Technology during the period 14-18 November 2005. Based upon the subsequent reviews of the system, all findings from the 2005 CPSR have been closed. The Georgia Institute of Technology's purchasing system is considered adequate to protect the Government's interest and the approval of your purchasing system is continued through 31 December 2008.

Continuation of the approval of Georgia Institute of Technology's purchasing system is given pursuant to FAR Subpart 44.3, and applies to all Federal Government contracts to the extent that cross-servicing arrangements exist. System approval shall automatically terminate at the end of the approval period (or approval period as extended), or when any significant change occurs in the system, unless approved by the Administrative Contracting Officer (ACO). System approval may be withdrawn at any time at the discretion of the ACO.

This approval may waive some of the consent and advance notification requirements for certain subcontracts per the subcontracting clause (FAR 52.244-2 and Agency Supplements).
