Subject: FY2010 Graduate Student Tuition Remission Program (GSTRP) Rates

Dear Mr. Karp:

This request is for your approval of FY2010 tuition remission rates covering graduate students employed by the Institute as Graduate Research Assistants, and Graduate Teaching Assistants (GRA/GTAs).

The proposed charge for tuition remission is \$759.00 per month. As agreed to in prior years, the method used in calculating the proposed hourly rate of \$10.40 for pricing GTRI proposals includes 44% average time (shown in the enclosure) for proposal purposes only. Because the actual percent time for each graduate student working on a project will be used when calculating the hourly tuition charge associated with that student's work on sponsored projects, the government will never be invoiced for more than the approved monthly tuition amount. The tuition charge, as detailed in the enclosed back-up information for the calculation, is based on rates approved by the Board of Regents. Proposed FY 2010 Graduate Student Tuition Remission Program Rates

May 6, 2009

In accordance with established procedures approved under date of August 22, 1996 by the Department of Navy, Office of Naval Research, the Georgia Institute of Technology provides tuition remission awards to graduate research assistants and graduate teaching assistants upon appointment, and direct charges the cost of such graduate tuition remission awards to benefiting sponsored projects. The amount of the tuition remission charge is established for each fiscal year based on approved tuition and fee rates for the fall term.

Attached are copies of the schedule that presents the Tuition and Fee rates for Fall 2009, Spring 2010 and Summer 2010 as published by the Bursar. GSTRP charge rates are determined from the Fall and Spring semester calendar which covers four and one-half months to include the period from August 16, 2009 until December 31, 2009 for the first semester, and January 1, 2010 until May 15, 2010 for the second semester. The Summer term for 2010 will cover a three month period from May 16, 2010 until August 15, 2010.

Based on procedures approved in prior years, and the new Tuition and Fee Rates, it is proposed that the FY2010 GSTRP Rates be established as follows:

Hourly GTRI GSTRP Charge for Use in Proposals: **\$ 10.40**

In-State/Out of State Classification

At the time of admission to Georgia Institute of Technology a student will be classified as either a resident or non-resident of the State of Georgia for determining the amount of tuition a student will be assessed. A student will either be assessed the resident (in-state) or non-resident (out-of-state) tuition rate listed above based on this determination. Policies and Procedures for determining the classification of residency status are set forth by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.

Mandatory Student Fees

Students taking 4 or more hours are required to pay the mandatory fees listed below. Students taking less than 4 hours are required to pay the Transportation Fee, the Technology Fee and the USG Institutional Fee. For the GTREP program, the amount of Mandatory Fees charged will be based upon the campus rates where the student is located plus the USG Institutional Fee (see rates above).
